This letter is to inform you that product Bonderite M-NT 65000 AERO manufactured at your plant location of Barcelona, Spain will be accepted for qualification to MIL-DTL-81706 Type II, Class 1A & 3, Form I, Method C. The product was submitted for qualification and tested under the product name Bonderite M-NT 65000. Letter SER-4342/19-028 was issued for Bonderite M-NT 65000; however, after testing and the accompanying letter were completed, the manufacturer changed the product name to Bonderite M-NT 65000 AERO. Therefore, the product will appear as Bonderite M-NT 65000 AERO on the Qualified Product List (QPL).

The following statements are binding upon the manufacturer per the Defense Standardization Manual 4120.24-M:

f. The QPL applies only to products or processes identical to those qualified or to products defined in the family of products granted qualification coverage. The supplier must inform the qualifying activity in advance of any intended change to the product or processes and must provide a complete description of the change. Failure to notify the qualifying activity of any change is cause for removal from the QPL regardless of the extent of the change.

g. Manufacturers must comply with a requirement for retention of qualification to remain on the QPL. Failure to comply is sufficient cause for removal from the QPL.
